Our Camp of Champs sessions are a great fit for new campers or those who may require a higher level of care. The LITE "Leaders in Training Experience" sessions are geared towards higher functioning individuals looking to build life and transitional skills, leadership and self advocacy. **All 6 day sessions are \$1,095. All 13 day sessions \$1,995.** Following successful completion of our LITE session, campers 18+ can participate in a 6 day Internship. **Internship tuition is \$525, and the 4 day is \$300.**

Both types of camps serve a number of disabilities including: ASD, LD, ADHD, OHD, Anxiety and Depression, FASD, and Attachment Disorder. The Camp Directors are former special needs teachers with a combined 35 years of teaching and camp management.
